COOKIE POLICY

Cookies are small text files that websites send to a user's device, where they are stored and then sent back to the same websites on the user's next visit.

2. What Cookies Are

Cookies allow the website to recognise a user's device and perform various functions, including enabling efficient navigation between pages, remembering any preferences, and improving the services offered.

Cookies can be:

- first-party, if installed directly by the website being visited;
- third-party, if installed by parties other than the website operator.

3. Types of Cookies Used

Technical Cookies

Technical cookies are necessary for the website to function correctly and to enable users to browse safely and efficiently.

This category includes, by way of example:

- browsing or session cookies;
- cookies necessary for the correct functioning of any restricted areas;
- cookies that store the preferences expressed by the user regarding cookies;
- technical cookies necessary for the security of the website.

The prior consent of the user is not required for the installation of these cookies.

Analytics Cookies

The website may use analytics cookies to collect statistical information, in aggregate form, on the number of users and how they visit the site.

Where such cookies allow the user to be identified or are not adequately anonymised, they will only be used with the user's prior consent, where required by applicable legislation.

Profiling and Marketing Cookies

Any profiling or marketing cookies will only be used with the user's prior consent, expressed through a dedicated banner or preference management tool.

As of the date of this notice, the website does not use profiling or marketing cookies, without prejudice to any future implementation, which will be subject to prior notice and, where necessary, user consent.

4. Purposes of Cookie Use

The cookies used by the website enable us to:

- ensure the correct technical functioning of the pages;
- enable efficient and secure browsing;
- store any user preferences;
- collect aggregate statistical data on website usage, where applicable;
- manage the preferences expressed through the cookie banner.

5. Legal Basis for Processing

The legal basis for processing is:

- the Data Controller's legitimate interest, with regard to technical cookies strictly necessary for the website to function;
- the user's consent, for non-anonymised analytics cookies and for any profiling or marketing cookies, where applicable.

The user may modify or withdraw any consent given at any time.

6. Managing Preferences

Users can manage their cookie preferences through the banner on the website, where active, or through their browser settings.

Disabling technical cookies may compromise the correct functioning of the website or limit some of its features.

7. Third-Party Cookies

The presence on the website of services provided by third parties, such as analytics tools, interactive maps, embedded content, contact systems or other external applications, may result in the installation of cookies by those parties.

In such cases, the related personal data processing is also governed by the notices provided by the respective providers.

8. Data Subject Rights

For information on the processing of personal data carried out through the website, and to exercise the rights provided for under Articles 15 et seq. of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, users may refer to the website's Privacy Notice and contact the Data Controller using the details provided in Section 1.

Users also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Commission (DPC), the Irish supervisory authority, or with the authority of their country of residence.
